**Membership:** Karyn Kambur reported that she had nothing to report.

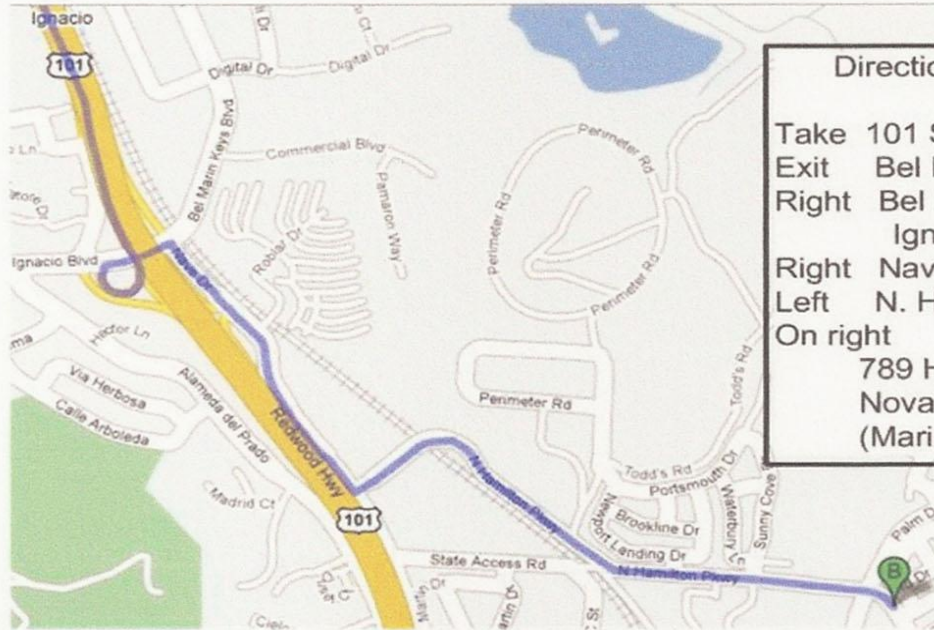
